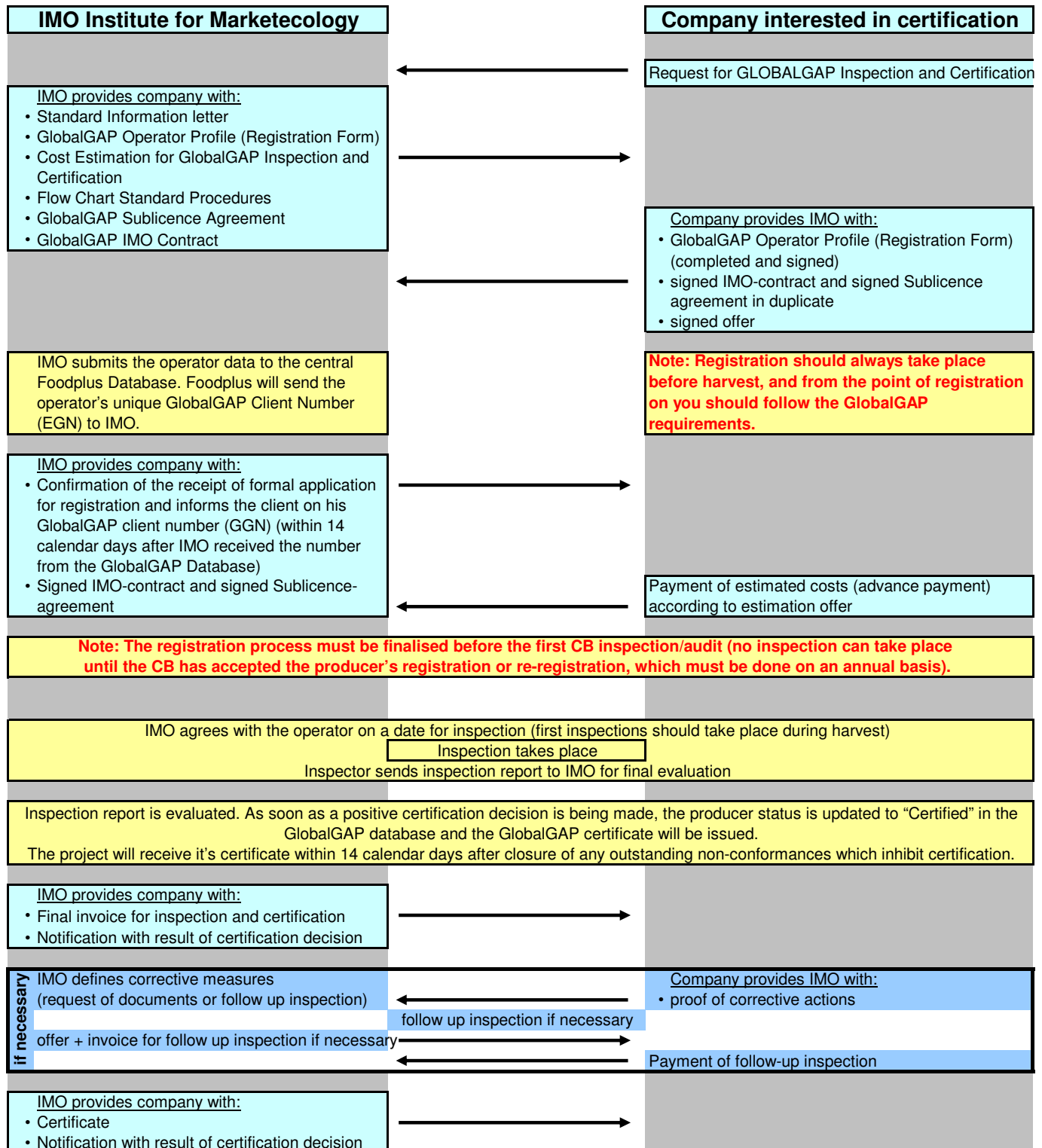


Steps to GLOBALG.A.P. certification



If non-conformances are detected:

- A warning is issued including time period allowed for correction (depending on criticality of the non-compliance, maximum 28 days). If the cause of the sanction is not resolved within the time period set (maximum of 28 days), a Suspension is imposed.
- When a suspension is imposed, time period for correction is allowed (maximum 6 months). During this time (period of suspension), the producer will be prevented from using the GlobalGAP logo/trademark, Licence/certificate or any other type of document that has any relation to GlobalGAP. Two types of Suspension exist:
 - Partial:** only certain part(s) of the certified product scope is/are suspended.
 - Complete:** all certified product scopes are suspended for a period of time set by the CB
- A cancellation of the contract will be issued when
 - A producer cannot show sufficient corrective action after a Partial or Complete Suspension has been issued and six months have elapsed
 - A non-conformance in one scope leads to doubt about the integrity of the produce,
 - when major contractual non-conformances are detected.
